

conditions, over muddy roads, over sandy roads, or where there was hardly any road at all took their toll."

In 1936, Father Harold Sherman, pastor, oversaw the construction of a new church. In 1970, construction began on yet another building. Msgr. Patrick Cunningham welcomed parishioners into the present-day St. Mary Church on Holy Thursday of 1972. The parish is also home to St. Mary Catholic School for students in pre-K4 through eighth grades.

Bishop John H. Ricard, SSJ dedicated the brand-new 35,000-squarefoot Msgr. Mullins Family Life Center for the growing parish June 8. Named for Msgr. Raymond Mullins, who was pastor of the parish from 1992 to 1999, the center will provide access to a gymnasium,
